PURPOSE

The Midwest District Council Undergraduate Scholarship Fund was established in 2017. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are enrolled in ministerial studies in AG endorsed colleges, universities, and Bible Schools.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on MDC church membership, academic performance, ministerial leadership potential, and participation in the local church. Scholarships are awarded annually, provided funds are available, in the amount of \$1,000.00 per semester for 2 years.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Midwest District Council awards scholarships based on a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The Midwest District Council pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships are awarded annually. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have attended an MDC church for at least one year prior to application.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant may not be older than 25 years of age on December 31 of the preceding year of application.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at an AG endorsed college, university or Bible School for the upcoming academic semester.
- Applicant must demonstrate a faithful testimony in his or her spiritual walk and a commitment to use their gifts, talents, and abilities to expand the Kingdom of God.
- Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential in the local church.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **April 30, 2024**.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due **April 30 of the current calendar year**.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by May 31, 2024.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A Pastoral reference letter from his or her local church.
- A one-page personal essay describing your spiritual walk and use of gifts, talents, and abilities to expand the Kingdom of God.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given upon the verification of enrollment to an AG endorsed college, university, or Bible School by the fall of the current year of approval.
- Applicant must provide their **student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be used**.
- Award amounts will be distributed annually after all requirements are met.
